POSITION DESCRIPTION: The intern will assist the Education Director during two week-long Summer Poetry Camps and summer CLC programming at Riverwest Elementary and Hopkins-Lloyd Community School. The intern will also work alongside local artist educators to teach literacy workshops and provide feedback to students participating in both programs.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE: Working in a professional manner with youth in grades K-12; assisting with the set-up, delivery, and clean-up of planned activities and meals; posting photos and updates to Woodland Pattern social media sites each day; and organizing handouts and journals each afternoon to prepare for the next day.

ARTISTIC DEVELOPMENT & TRAINING: Throughout the summer, the intern will be immersed in teaching, writing, and artistic production, working with a diverse team of writing instructors and guest artists. The intern will have opportunities to practice writing and working in different mediums as they create art with the students. Finally, the intern will gain experience and confidence in mentoring students, expand their artistic network, and receive valuable job experience.

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants must be a City of Milwaukee resident or an MPS high school student and at least 15 years old. Ideal candidates will have strong writing and organizational skills as well as interests in poetry, the arts, and working with children.
